60-80cm:- Hedgerow planting with spirals and canes.

## Rural hedge mix - Ready made pack

A mixture of hedging plants normally found in well established rural hedges.

Composition:-

50% Hawthorn, 12.5% Blackthorn, 12.5% Field Maple, 12.5% Hazel, 7% Spindle and 6% Dogwood.

Quantity:-

Four plants per metre.

Planting and pest protection:-

Plant in double staggered row 45cm between plants. Protect using Rabbit spirals supported with a bamboo cane.

**Introduction:** Plant sizes and pest protection.

**Size:** Coniferous trees are planted between 20-40cm tall because of their fast growth rate. All plants are at least 2 years old and have been transplanted at least once.

All Christmas tree stock is grown from specially selected seed to produce high quality tree of good form.

**Protection:** Most Conifers do not thrive in tree shelters. We suggest Rabbit or Deer fencing for large plantings. See page 10 for prices.

Prices may be subject to revision during the season. Quotations remain valid for 60 days. All items are offered subject to remaining unsold on receipt of order.
- PAYMENT** Payment shall be made at the time of order unless an approved credit account has been opened, in which case payment shall be made within 28 days of invoice.
- NEW CUSTOMERS** New customers are requested to supply two trade references and one bank reference in order to open a credit account. This first order must be paid at the time of collection/delivery. Orders can normally be collected at 7 days notice in the season subject to prior arrangements and open weather.
- HOURS OF BUSINESS:** Mondays to Fridays - 8.0am to 5.00pm (Closed 12.30-1.30pm). All items can be delivered. Please telephone the Nursery to obtain details of delivery charges.
- WARRANTY:** All plants are guaranteed to be healthy and sound in every way when they leave our Nursery and they will grow for you if given intelligent and reasonable care. In the event of there being any cause for complaint we must be notified in writing within 7 days of receipt of goods as we cannot be held responsible for any subsequent loss.
